

Attempted Theft Of Policeman's Car Brings Sentence of 30 Months

FOUND guilty in a Fifty-fourth district court jury Tuesday of attempting to steal an automobile, belonging to Patrolman R. M. Brownlow, while that officer was looking on, W. C. Holder was sentenced to 30 months in prison, to which will be added a three-year suspended sentence for a similar offense in Wichita Falls. Holder was shot in the hip when he attempted to get away from Brownlow after the incident last August. Assistant District Attorney Jimmy Stanford prosecuted the case.
