Tast Will and Testament

THE STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF MCLENNAN

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, Jeff D. Brownlow, of the County of McLennan, State of Texas, being in good health, of sound and disposing mind and memory, and being of lawful age, do make and publish this, my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

FIRST. I direct that all of my just debts and the expenses of my last sickness and funeral, shall be paid out of my estate by my Executrix or Joint Independent Executors, hereinafter named, as soon after my decease as may be found convenient.

SECOND. All of the rest and residue of my estate and property which I may own at the time of my death, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible, of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, including my interest in all community property, I give and bequeath to my wife, Louise Brownlow, to be her separate property in fee simple, and for her use and enjoyment, and to be disposed of as she may desire.

THIRD. In the event that my wife should predecease me, or that we should die at the same time or within a period of thirty (30) days of each other, then I give and bequeath all of my property, real and personal, wherever situate, and including all of my interest in all community property, after the payment of my debts and funeral expenses as above provided, to my two children, Arthur Eugene Brownlow and Jenita Ann Ferguson, to them and to their respective descendants.

FOURTH. I name and appoint my wife, Louise Brownlow, to be Independent Executrix of this Will and of my estate. In the event that she should predecease me or be unwilling or unable to act as such, then I appoint my children, Arthur Eugene Brownlow and Jenita Ann Ferguson, to be Joint Independent Executors of this Will and of my estate. In the event that either Joint Independent Executor should predecease me or be unable to act as such, then I appoint my remaining child to serve alone as Independent Executor. I direct that no bond or security shall ever be required of my Executrix or Joint Independent Executors in such capacity and I direct that no action shall be had in probate or county court in relation to the settlement of my estate, other than the probating and recording of this Will and the return of the statutory inventory, appraisement and list of claims of my estate.
