Doar Sir: I am in receipt of yours of the 24th inst, making inquiries as to LKROY V. CRISWELL, and in answer will say that I am a som of the said LWROY V. CRISWELL, and I was 77 years of age on last Oct. 18th, 1986, and I was born near old Flatonia in Fayette county, Toxas.

with reference to my father's discharge from the army ar BEYAR or CAMP REYAR, will say that the enclosed is a copy of the original discharge which I copied more than forty (40) years ago, the original was then in the possession of my deceased Bro., Henry E. Criswell of Yoakum Texas.

The original discharge may be in the possession of Billy (OR W.H.) Criswell now of Yoakum, Tex.

In so far as I know my father, Leroy V.Orlswell, first settled at BLACK Springs near what is now Muldoon, and thereafter moved and settled near old Flatenia in Payette Co.

Loroy V. Criswell died in the year 1865 at which time I was about 62 years of age.

My father is buried in what was known as the DUFF grave yard or osmetery which is about 1 to 1 mile 8.E. from the village known as PRABA which is 8.E. from Flatonia.

My resollection is that my father's grave has no marker by which it could be identified from other graves.

My antecedents came to Toxas, in the year 1829, and the family consisted of my grand father Criswell who went on a business trip to Ky., soon after coming to Toxas, and there died in Ky. while he was there, and in so far as I can remember his family consisted of the following sons and daughters to wit:

liy father's discharge (if I did not make a mistake in dates) shows to have been issued Hov. 24th,1835, while in your letter to me you state that he Lorey V. Criswell, was at the taking of Bahak (Ean Antonio) on Dec. 5th to 10th,1835.

But however, my father may have remeined at OAMP 93749 for some time after his discharge was issued to him.

william V. Criswell is ouried in the same grave yard or cometery in which my father is buried as stated above, and William V.Criswell's grave can be easily located, as it had considerable rock and cement work placed over it.

Thanking you for your lindness and hoping that I have herein given you such information relative to Lercy V. Criswell as you wish to have in your Historical research, and with kind legards and best wishes. I remain.
