of the United States as a Volunteer under
the command of Captain Joseph Roper of
Col. Guilford Dudley's Regiment, the expedition
against the ~~South~~ Courthouse N. Ca against
the Tories who were in Orange County N. Ca
under command of Col. Bectorck Hill
& David Hanning (both notorious in said State)
The Battle in which I had the misfortune
to receive my wound took place between
our party and the aforesaid Tories on the
13th day of September 1781 at a certain
