to James J. Foster of said county all the  
right title interest claim and demand  
which I in any wise possess to one labor  
certificate of land issued in Fayette County  
to John G. Ciswell and by him transferred  
to me March 6<sup>th</sup> 1838 the said certificate  
being herewith delivered over that the title  
may issue to said Foster his heirs or  
assigns in as full and ample a manner  
as I can make the same -
