

FOUR KIDDIES IN PITIABLE PLIGHT

BROWNLOWE IS IN JAIL, MOTHER
OF CHILDREN IS
DEAD.

ORPHAN'S HOME ONLY REFUGE

Probation Officer to Take Charge,
Clements on Trial Fourth Time,
Venire for Marquez.

On the allegation that they are dependent and neglected children, proceedings were instituted in county court yesterday to have Archie, aged 12; Bertie, aged 9; Hetty, aged 6, and Maudy, aged 4 years, children of E. A. Brownlowe, declared dependent and placed in charge of the county probation officer.

In the event this action is taken homes will be found for the children at one of the orphan homes of the city.

Probation Officer Acts.

Probation Officer E. E. Ingram, in connection with the county attorney's office, prepared the affidavit declaring the children dependent. Hearing on the question has been set for Wednesday in county court. This action followed the arrest of E. A. Brownlowe and his confinement in the county jail. The man was indicted by the grand jury on statutory charge. The petition asking that the children be declared dependent alleges that they are being neglected, that their mother is dead and the father unable to care for them, and that he is now confined in the jail. The children at present are being kept at the home of an elder and married brother. It is said he is unable to provide for them.

Probation Officer Ingram will appear in court and ask that they be turned over to him.

The Brownlowes resided near China Springs.
